PRINCE2® (P**RO**jects **I**N **C**ontrolled **E**nvironments) is a project management methodology designed to ensure that projects meet their objectives, within constraints and deliver stated benefits. The course includes the PRINCE2® Foundation certification exam.

You will also need to complete the pre course reading provided prior to attending the course.

AFTER THE COURSE YOU WILL

- ❖ Have a general understanding and know how to apply PRINCE2 and its 7 principles, 7 processes, 7 themes, checklists and roles in real projects
- ❖ Be a qualified PRINCE2 Foundation (subject to passing exam)

TRAINING METHODS

This will be achieved by a combination of slide presentations and exercises designed to prepare you for the foundation examination. The PRINCE2® Foundation certification exam is part of the course

PREREQUISITES

Participants will receive a copy of the PRINCE2® Manual and a pre-course Workbook prior to attending.

It is strongly advised that participants begin the pre-course work and reading (in total some 20 hours) no later than 2 weeks prior to the course start date.
